Senate President Steven Sweeney serves the 3rd Legislative District. Elected to the Senate in 2001, he has served as Senate President since 2010. An ironworker by trade, Senator Sweeney has been a strong advocate for organized labor and the rights of workers, having sponsored laws to raise New Jersey's minimum wage and create the state's Paid Family Leave program.

One of his most recently sponsored legislation is the "New Jobs for New Jersey Act", a bill that seeks to create incentives for employers to hire NJ's unemployed. The Bill passed the Senate and is currently being reviewed by the Assembly's Commerce and Economic Development Committee.

In an effort to help improve the state's economy Senate President Sweeney has advocated for a stable funding source for New Jersey's Transportation Trust Fund. The Senate President believes that repairing New Jersey's bridges, roads and railways will attract businesses to our state and create jobs.

Senate President Sweeney is considered a front-runner for the Democratic Party's nominee for Governor.
